~ Legislation Updates – The continuation of the HB 3636 legislation (Cypress Creek/Mechanics Lien) will heat up again in September. The next opportunity to support your favor of the bill will be a Public Hearing, Sept. 24th, 11 am, at the Michael A. Bilandic Building, 160 N. LaSalle St., Rm. 600, 11 am. CRCA is working to put the sub-contractor back ahead of banks in line should the building owner default on construction payments. ~ IL Energy Code Changes – Straight from the State

“Per our legislative liaison, the Governor has signed SB 3724 which extends the implementation date of the 2012 IECC to January 1, 2013 and also increases the amount of time for implementation after a new code is published from one year to 16 months.” (CRCA NOTE: The 16 months is for the 2015 version of the code, not this version)

As a result, insulation requirements in Illinois including Chicago will change from R20 to R25 and a continuous air barrier will be required effective January 1, 2013. Unless changes are made during the future hearing of the Joint Committee of Administrative Rules,

R-25 insulation and an air barrier will be required for all new, reroofs and tear offs once the new code is enacted. Why? When the State of Illinois accepted Federal Stimulus Funds the state agreed to verify 90% compliance to 2012 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC) by 2017. Prior to accepting funds, the State of Illinois passed legislation to adopt the each version of the IECC one year after publication by the International Code Council, currently every three years. This legislation means that home rule authority is overridden by the State because the code is a 'state law', similar to the Americans with Disabilities Act. Municipalities can adapt more stringent requirements than is required by the new code, but not less.

The change has been announced by the State of Illinois that the effective date has changed from July 1, 2012 to January 1, 2013. Future adoptions will take place 16 months from the date of publication of the International Energy Conservation Code.

To assist building owners and managers, CRCA has sought relief for renovations where it is impractical to raise HVAC units, perimeter blocking and other details that would make it uneconomical to buy a new roof. This would possibly allow the R-20ci as currently is required rather than increasing to R-25. We have also requested an exception in renovations for the continuous air barrier as well.

There are indications that CRCA's requests might be accepted, but no guarantees are in place. For now, count on the legislation as it passed the governor's office. Visit the CRCA website (<http://www.crca.org>) for a complete explanation, under the 'industry resources' tab.

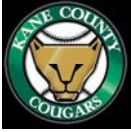
